



Taking Target 5 Days to the next level

With work on Phase 1 of the project nearing completion, the tools and processes of Target 5 Days are ready to be applied to other development use types.

Initially, the Target 5 Days project focused on duplexes and multi-unit developments. Subsequently, an Application Kit and streamlined assessment process was developed to cater for these use types.

In Phase 2 of Target 5 Days, the principles and processes of the project can now be expanded to cater for additional use types. 'Reconfiguration of a lot' (ROL) applications, also known as subdivisions, will be the focus of the next stage of the project.

To facilitate this process, the Target 5 Days project team has already conducted online file surveys to gather key information about ROL applications received by participating councils over the past 12 months.

The HAF Programme will be making contact with the relevant councils over the coming week to begin discussions about the next phase of the project, with risk analysis of key issues to commence soon after.

It is estimated that development of the draft tools for ROL applications will be completed in late April /early May. This will allow time for council consultation and further refinement before the tools are finalised in late May.

With some participating councils still finalising work on Phase 1, the HAF Programme will work closely with each council to ensure a smooth transition into the next stage of the project.
