Key points for Queensland local government

We are pleased to see ...



\$200m for Works for Queensland over 4 years for councils to boost local jobs and community infrastructure.

\$280m over 4 years for the Transport Infrastructure Development Scheme (TIDS) to continue to provide safer roads.



\$3m over 2 years to expand QCoast₂₁₀₀ program to help councils prepare communities for climate risk.

\$50m in economic stimulus for SEQ councils over 4 years.



Council access to an additional **\$20m through the Queensland Tourism Activation Fund**.

An additional **\$6m over 4 years for the prevention of domestic and family violence** in vulnerable populations.



We will continue to work towards ...



Long term commitment to **Works for Qld with \$100m pa** to continue to create local jobs where they are most needed.

Extra \$500m to ensure safe and reliable water supply and wastewater management for rural and remote communities.



Increased TIDS funding to keep up with demand for safe and reliable roads and support hundreds of local jobs.



\$50m pa for SEQ Community Stimulus package to support hundreds more local jobs.



A \$200m Sustainability Fund to support council resource recovery and waste management initiatives.

10 per cent increase to State Government Financial Aid (SGFA) to First Nations councils to boost local Indigenous employment.
